**Optomanager** - LOCSU preferred patient management software for MECS, GRR, Community management of stable glaucoma, etc

**OSCE:** Objective Structured Clinical Examination.

PAH - Princes Alexander Hospital, Harlow, West Essex (WE)

**SCR:** Summary Care Record. NHS. Created from GP records. Patient identifiers. Present meds. Drug allergies / sensitivities. Major health issues. Accessed by authorised health professionals. See also PDS. Patients can opt out of SCR

SIRO: Serious Information Risk Officer

**SLC:** Service Level Agreement
