Condition	Form	Referral Method
<b>Emergency &amp; Urgent</b>	LOC Referral Form	Phone Primary Care Centre on 01206 746066 & option 6, for advice, then, use NHS mail to email referral to eyereferurgent@esneft.nhs.uk Not for patients chasing referrals
<b>Wet AMD</b>	AMD Referral Form	Use NHS mail to email referral to esneft.amdreferralcolchester@nhs.net on AMD referral form.
<b>Routine</b>	LOC Referral Form	Use NHS mail to email referral to the Ophthalmology booking department for triage at esneft.eyedepartmentcolchester@nhs.net Or LOC referral form via GP
<b>Cataract</b>	LOC Referral Form	No specialised pathway. Follow routine route as above. Referral must state if the patient wishes to have the operation. Alternatively, you can send directly to one of the Independent Service Providers at: <a href="https://essex-loc.org/isp/">https://essex-loc.org/isp/</a>
<b>IOP &gt;23</b>	LOC Referral Form	Refer direct to practitioner on GRR scheme via LOC referral form. Details of participating practices & restrictions at: <a href="https://essex-loc.org/enhanced-services/enhanced-services-north-essex/">https://essex-loc.org/enhanced-services/enhanced-services-north-essex/</a>
<b>MECS</b>	LOC Referral Form	Refer to practitioner on MECs scheme via LOC referral form. Patients can self-refer or present having been sign-posted by any health care provider. <b>Paediatrics</b>	LOC Referral Form	Patient can be referred to one of practices on list found at <a href="https://essex-loc.org/enhanced-services/enhanced-services-north-essex/">https://essex-loc.org/enhanced-services/enhanced-services-north-essex/</a>
<b>Post Op Cataract Service</b>	Electronically via Opera system	Follow pathway supplied by Primary Eyecare Services when you registered Second eye referral done through Opera online system. Emergency referrals: as above. Second eye referrals should be made to the original provider.
<b>Suspect Stroke</b>	LOC Referral Form	Colchester Hospital will accept referrals for "Transient, painless unilateral loss of vision (TIA/Amaurosis Fugax)" and "new painless bilateral field defect".
